EASEWE: Improving migrant women self-employment in the creative sector



<u>EASEWE</u> is a recently concluded Erasmus + project about entrepreneurial education for creative self-employment of women. The project's main objective was to help migrant women to develop their entrepreneurial skills and start their own business in the creative arts sector.

The partnership, coordinated by Net in Action, counted on the expertise of 6 partners from 6 countries (Italy, Cyprus, Sweden, Spain, Slovenia, Hungary) representing both the business, culture and education sectors. The participants' achievement and the project's outstanding results have been highlighted during the final event, particularly a training course for women with migrant backgrounds who wish to overcome their employment obstacles through self-employment. The 12 modules of the

training courses make use of the blended learning approach to provide basic skills in the digital, entrepreneurial and creative market fields.

Besides improving their digital and entrepreneurial competences, participants felt empowered to become effective players in the labor market and inspired to develop their own business projects. This is why we like to think about this initiative as one of the multiple starting points for a journey towards emancipation and empowerment!
